



Save The Music Foundation Keys + Kids Grant

In response to the growing need for high-quality, functional pianos in public schools, and to provide even more students with a safe and inclusive community to be outstanding through the arts, Save The Music created the Keys + Kids piano grant program (pronounced “keys plus kids”).

The grant includes \$15,000 worth of new musical instruments and equipment, including:

1 Casio Celviano Grand Hybrid Piano:

- The most advanced technology in digital pianos
- Sounds acoustic and has weighted keys, but does not require regular tuning and maintenance like an acoustic piano
- Features include the ability to audio and midi record and playback, split keyboard in duet mode, adjust acoustical system and sound, and much more!
- Includes piano bench

10 Casio WK-7600 Keyboard Workstations:

- 76-key digital keyboard offering 820 tones, 260 preset rhythms, 17 track sequencer, 32 channel mixer, as well as audio recording capabilities
- This keyboard will allow students to compose, record and perform their compositions
- Workstation includes gig bags for storage and allows teachers and students to safely take keyboards home to practice
- Workstations include double-brace keyboard stands for easy playing

Grant Requirements:

- Be a K-12 public school
- Have, or plan to hire, at least one full-time certified music teacher on staff
- The school's music program must be taught during the regular school day
- School has a dedicated music classroom space
- Principal or school leader must submit a letter of support
